How to get to The Grange Country Club

From the M53:

Take Junction 4 onto the B5151, sign posted Willaston/Neston, for approximately half a mile. Turn Right onto the B5136, sign posted Thornton Hough/Neston. Make your way through Thornton Hough village and we are situated just on the other side of the village on the right hand side.

From the M6:

Take Junction 20 onto the M56, and then take Junction 15 onto the M53, making sure you follow the signs for Ellesmere Port/Birkenhead, then follow directions as above. **

From Liverpool:

Take the Kingsway Tunnel onto the M53. Take Junction 4 and then follow directions as above. **

From Chester:

Take the A540 to Heswall. Follow this road for approximately 10 miles and turn right onto the B5136, sign posted Thornton Hough.

Follow this road for approximately 1/2 mile and we are on the left.
